YOUTH COMMITTEE REPORT: Michele reported that she was in the process of putting together the scholarship money due each youth bowler and will be turning in soon.

One youth team went to the state tournament in Medford and finished 3 in their division. Kathie and Grant Dunigan finished 1st in their division for Doubles with achieving their highest series. Kathie 578 and Grant 791. Brandon Coffey and Austin Bynum finished 3rd in their division. In Singles Grant Dunigan had a 750 series to finish 1st in his division.

LANE INSPECTION COMMITTEE REPORT: Chris Simmons provided the attached report and reported that the lanes have been in compliance with USBC standards.

FINANCIAL COMMITTEE REPORT: Sheila Heineck reported that the finance committee had met February 8th 2006, to review and audit the Lebanon USBC books for the 2005-2006 season everything had been provided by the Association Manager and that all was in order. See attached copy of letter.

President Emmett opened nominations for Director F position currently held by Howard Gabel. Ronda Bennett nominated Howard it was followed by a 2nd from Gene Braught. Nominations were closed Howard was re-elected to the Director F position.

President Emmett opened nominations for Youth Director B position currently held by Cheryl Simmons. Ronda Bennett nominated Cheryl it was followed by a 2nd from Howard Gabel. Nominations were closed Cheryl was re-elected to the Youth Director B position.
